- Matches are the best of 3 or 5 games, at the option of the competition organiser. Each game is point a rally scoring to 11 (PAR 11). If the score in a game is tied at 10-10, a player must win by 2 clear points.

Qualification Criteria

- Depending on the number of registrations, players play Round Robin in the Qualification Stage in one or separate groups.
- The first 4 placings in each category, qualify to the Finals.
- In case the number of players is 4, the players qualify directly to the Finals.
- The minimum number of players for the Finals to take place is 3.
- In case the number of players is less than 3, the competition will not take place.

In case the first 4 placings are not determined immediately by the end of the tournament, placings will be determined on the following criteria:

1. *direct encounter*
2. *games difference*
3. *points difference*
4. *number of points scored in favour*
